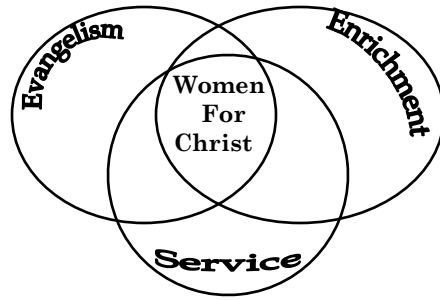

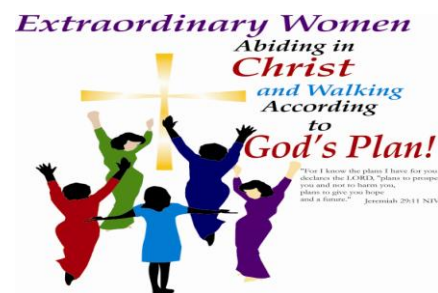

DIRECTIONS: Listed below are the planned workshops for your enrichment. Please select three topics of your choice by listing the alphabet which identifies the class for your first and second choices.

A. Obedience: Yes To Your Will, Yes To Your Way! First Steps to Becoming More Obedient to God and Trusting His Will and His Way For Your Life ~Luke 11:28 (NLT) *Tired of living life your way and still not getting the best results? Learn first steps to becoming more obedient to God and trusting His will and His way for your life.*

B. Relationships: The Good Shepherd: Strengthening Your Relationship With God, Surrendering Control and Allowing Him to Lead You to Your Purpose ~John 17:3 *How can you have a relationship with God if you don't spend time with Him? Learn how to seek God first, pray and study His Word daily to build your relationship with Him.*

C. Forgiveness: God Forgives...Do You? ~Matthew 6:14-15 (NIV) – *Jesus says to forgive up to seventy times seven. How does your math in forgiving add up? If we can't forgive our brothers and sisters then how do we expect God to forgive us?*

D. Finances: Going From Broke to Blessed...Tithing Works! ~Deuteronomy 16:17 (NIV) and Luke 6:28 (NIV) – *Reevaluate and realigning your trust that God will open up the windows of Heaven and pour out blessings.*

E. Women In The Ministry: Words of Wisdom From Women of Faith Who Have Been Called To Preach God's Word~II Timothy 4:5 (NLT) –*Giving God the Glory! Honoring and magnifying God in your ministry life.*

F. Health and Fitness: Healthy Bodies for Christ ~I Corinthians 6:19-20 (NLT) – *Your body is a temple for Christ. Fit hearts and clear minds will create and strengthen your work for Jesus. Come and learn how to work it out!*

G. Bereavement and Grief: God, I Need Your Comfort ~II Corinthians 1:3-7 (NIV), Matthew 5:4 (NIV), and John 11:23-26 (NIV) *Jesus gives us comfort through bereavement, trials and tribulations. Learn effective strategies to comfort others during difficult times.*

H. Balancing Work and Family: The Balancing Act of a Virtuous Woman ~Proverbs 31:10-31 (NIV) – *Learn how to fine tune and balance the characteristics which define a virtuous woman.*

I. Hope: The Audacity of Hope: The Necessity and Importance of Hope in Your Daily Faith Walk ~Romans 15:4 – *The necessity and importance of hope in your daily faith walk. In this session you will learn how to endure and persevere through all of the issues you may face daily by trusting and believing God's Word.*

J. Worship: How Great Is Our God! Worship Him With No Limits...Taking God Out of a Box and Accepting that He Can Move in Diverse and Unexpected Ways. ~Romans 12:1-2 (NIV) and Psalm 100:1-5 (NIV) –*By exploring worship we will find out how we should worship God and make worship pleasing and acceptable to Him*

K. Prayer and Daily Devotions: Pray Without Ceasing ~I Thessalonians 5:17 (NIV), Luke 18:1 (NIV), Psalm 99:1-9 (NIV), John 15:7 (NIV) –*Discover the steps to having a successful prayer life while learning the prerequisites of answered prayer.*

L. Evangelism: Become a Spiritual Rescuer!~ Matthew 28:19-20 (NIV), John 4:35 (NIV) *Catch the life line of Jesus! Discover successful strategies and techniques for soul winning.*

M. Dreamgirls (Female Teenagers ages 13-17): Real Issues, Real Life! ~I Peter 3:3-4 (NIV). *In today's society, emphasis is placed on outward beauty, designer clothes, and that "thin is in." In this workshop, you will explore topics about witnessing to other teens, how to study the Bible, peer pressure, and building self-esteem. Your beauty should not come from outward adornment, such as braided hair and the wearing of gold jewelry and fine clothes. Instead, it should be that of your inner self, the unfading beauty of gentle and quiet spirit, which is of great worth in God's sight." 1 Peter 3: 3- 4*

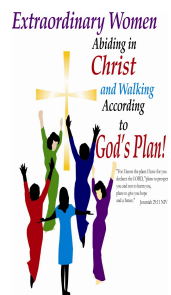
