





**DIRECTIONS**: Listed below are the planned workshops for your enrichment. Please select three topics of your choice by listing the alphabet which identifies the class for your first <u>and</u> second choices.

- A. Obedience: Yes To Your Will, Yes To Your Way! First Steps to Becoming More Obedient to God and Trusting His Will and His Way For Your Life ~Luke 11:28 (NLT) Tired of living life your way and still not getting the best results? Learn first steps to becoming more obedient to God and trusting His will and His way for your life.
- B. Relationships: The Good Shepherd: Strengthening Your Relationship With God, Surrendering Control and Allowing Him to Lead You to Your Purpose ~John 17:3 How can you have a relationship with God if you don't spend time with Him? Learn how to seek God first, pray and study His Word daily to build your relationship with Him.
- **C.** <u>Forgiveness:</u> God Forgives...Do You? ~Matthew 6:14-15 (NIV) Jesus says to forgive up to seventy times seven. How does your math in forgiving add up? If we can't forgive our brothers and sisters then how do we expect God to forgive us?

- F. Health and Fitness: Healthy Bodies for Christ ~I Corinthians 6:19-20 (NLT) Your body is a temple for Christ. Fit hearts and clear minds will create and strengthen your work for Jesus. Come and learn how to work it out!
- G. Bereavement and Grief: God, I Need Your Comfort ~II Corinthians 1:3-7 (NIV), Matthew 5:4 (NIV), and John 11:23-26 (NIV) Jesus gives us comfort through bereavement, trials and tribulations. Learn effective strategies to comfort others during difficult times.


